Pursuant to the Memorandum of Understanding for Court Security Services, entered into in June of 2013 between the Superior Court of California, County of Lassen, and the Lassen County Sheriff, the Sheriff assumed responsibility for all court security services pursuant to Government Code sections 69920 through 69927. As of the date of this General Order, no subsequent Memorandum of Understanding has been entered into.

Government Code section 69926, subsection (f), provides that the terms of the aforementioned Memorandum of Understanding shall remain in effect, and the Sheriff shall continue to provide the court security services set forth in the Memorandum of Understanding, until the parties enter into a new memorandum of understanding.

Therefore, until a new memorandum of understanding is entered into, it is hereby ordered that:

1. The terms of the Memorandum of Understanding for Court Security Services, entered into in June of 2013 between the Superior Court of California, County of Lassen, and the Lassen County Sheriff remain in effect; and
2. The Sheriff shall continue to be responsible and to provide for all court security services, including but not limited to: all bailiff functions in all criminal and non-criminal actions, attending court, courtroom security for Judicial Officers and courtroom staff, traditional bailiff duties, holding facility operations, control room operations, screening operations, and perimeter patrol.
